



Please read the following rules before consigning any animals

PAUS Sale Terms & Conditions

Identification

- All animals' tattoos must be legible and corresponding to its registration certificate. Any animal without a tattoo will not sell.
- It is the responsibility of the buyer to check tattoos for accuracy.
- The official registered name, accompanied by the registration number and level of registry for Appendix animals shall be given for each animal.
- In the case of embryo transfer {ET}, the first owner {seller} must provide the ET certificate and AI certificates.

Health

- All animals will be eligible for interstate shipment unless otherwise announced. Interstate health papers must be furnished for each animal.
- Each animal requiring TB and bangs test will have been tested within 30 days of sale date. Such test will have been made by a federally accredited veterinarian and samples will have been processed by a federally accredited laboratory.
- All animals should be free of parasites, wormed and have all recommended shots. It is the responsibility of the buyer to know the health requirements of his/her home state.
- All bulls 15 months of age and older must be semen tested, and tricanosis tested if they are not virgin bulls.

Breeding Guarantees for Bulls

- All bulls of breeding age, (15 months of age or older) will be guaranteed fertile and able to settle healthy cows within 6 months of the sale.

Breeding Guarantees for Females

- Females, no guarantee will be given that bred females will deliver a live calf.
- All animals selling safe in calf will have been examined by a licensed veterinarian with pregnancy examination papers.
- All females of breeding age will be guaranteed to be breeders within 6 months after the sale date.
- Females sold safe in calf as determined by a licensed veterinarian. If the female proves not to be in calf to the bull stated, in the time frame stated, the buyer can exercise his choice of options as follows:
- Request a full and prompt refund of the purchase price upon return of the female to the seller's farm.
- Request an adjustment to the purchase price or request service to the bull previously used, if available.

Options for Return or Adjustments

- In the event a bull or female that has not been proven to be a breeder and is in healthy condition and of breeding age.
- The bull or female may be returned to the seller at the buyer's expense.
- Seller will reserve the right to prove the bull or female fertile within a 6 months period. If the bull or female are proven to be breeders, they will be returned to the buyer at the buyer's expense.
- Should the animal fail to be a breeder, the seller has the option of either returning the purchase price to the buyer or replacing the animal with another of equal value as full settlement to satisfaction of claim.

Exceptions to Guarantee

- All animals are guaranteed to be breeders unless:
 - a. They fail to breed due to injury or disease occurring after purchase.
 - b. If the animal is fitted and shown for exhibition purposes.
- Bulls are guaranteed breeders:
 - a. Provided that bull is not allowed to run with the cow herd, until at least 15 months of age.
 - b. Provided the cow herd is healthy.
 - c. Fertility guarantee does not imply the ability to freeze semen. Such will require an additional agreement between buyer and seller.
- Females are guaranteed breeders unless:
 - a. The female is subjected to any hormonal surgical or non surgical reproductive techniques prior to being bred for a natural calf.

AI and/or ET Service Certificates

- AI Service Certificates shall be furnished by the seller at no cost to the buyer, for all females bred artificially.
- ET Certificates shall be furnished by the seller at no cost to the buyer for all offspring resulting from ET.
- Embryos will have an ET Certificate furnished by the seller at no cost to the buyer for all embryos sold.
- Natural Service Certificates shall be furnished by the seller at no cost to the buyer for all females bred by natural service stating all bull and service dates.

Purchaser's Risk

- Each animal becomes the property of the buyer as soon as sold, unless arrangements are made prior to the sale.

Contract

- The above terms and guarantees shall constitute a contract between the buyer and the seller of each animal sold. All claims must be settled prior to the buyers disposing of or slaughtering any animal. Seller reserves the option to issue credits for any claims.
